Subject: Chi-X Australia Business Continuity Plan (BCP) Event - 1st June 2019

Chi-X will be performing a business continuity event on **Saturday 1st June 2019** as part of a regular series of BCP exercises.

This event will focus on the failover of major system components within the Primary data centre (Equinix SY2) from their **Primary** instance to their **Standby/Secondary** instance. Attendance is not compulsory, however Chi-X participants and vendors are encouraged to take part.

Please be aware that all Multicast market data clients will receive market data flow on Saturday 1st June and therefore will need to ensure that their systems handle/ignore the data accordingly.

Prerequisites for participating in the BCP event

Please **email your request to participate to Chi-X** and also to your trading application vendor (if applicable) by the end of business **Friday 17th May 2019** including:

Logins you wish to use during the test (Market data, OUCH and FIX-based logins which includes Trade Feed, 3rd Party Consolidated Feed, COG and FIX order entry). All other logins not requested will be disabled during the test;

Your firm's primary **contact name, email, phone number** during the test.

Testing Timetable

Chi-X Production systems will be open from 07:30 to 11:00 (AEST). Chi-X and ASX have offset their respective BCP schedules on that day to best align with client resources. The trading date for all transactions executed on Chi-X will be Saturday 1st June.

07:30 - Connectivity available for Market data, OUCH and FIX based logins;

08:00 - Trade reporting enabled;

08:30 - Chi-X market open for order entry and continuous trading. Trades performed during the test will not flow to CHES;

08:45 - Chi-X to perform various internal system failover scenarios including the matching engine;

09:30 - Participant and Vendor login connections to failover from the Primary instance to the Standby/Secondary instance:

OUCH and FIX-based logins will failover from the Primary to the **Standby** instance;

Market data Primary connections will be disabled and **Secondary** connections will persist;

11:00 - Market Close. Logins will be disconnected. All order and trade activity performed during the test will be deleted from Chi-X systems.
